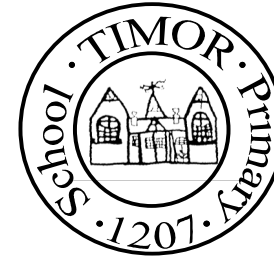

MEDICATION TO BE GIVEN AT SCHOOL
